Place value with numbers up to Ten Thousand
Formal written methods for all 4 c calculations (+ - x and ÷)

Examples:

789 + 642 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} 789 \\ + 642 \\ \hline 1431 \\ \hline 1 \quad 1 \end{array}$$

932 - 457 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} 8 \quad 12 \quad 1 \\ 932 \\ - 457 \\ \hline 475 \end{array}$$

124 × 26 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} 1 \quad 2 \\ 124 \\ \times 26 \\ \hline 744 \\ 2480 \\ \hline 3224 \\ \hline 1 \quad 1 \end{array}$$

432 ÷ 5 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} 86 \text{ r}2 \\ 5 \overline{) 432} \\ \underline{40} \\ 32 \\ \underline{30} \\ 2 \\ \underline{2} \\ 0 \\ \hline \end{array}$$
